UN VOLUME INÉDIT DE LOUIS FRÉCHETTE

Louis Fréchette, Mémoires intimes, texte établi et annoté par George A. Klinck, Montréal et Paris, Fides, (1961). 200 p. \$2.00.

Le vingt-troisième volume de l'élégante collection du Nénuphar ("Les meilleurs auteurs canadiens") nous présente un précieux inédit du premier grand auteur du Canada français, Louis Fréchette (1839-1908). Il s'agit des Mémoires intimes du poète, qui parurent en grande partie dans les colonnes du Monde Illustré de Montréal en 1900. L'édition annotée que nous procure actuellement le docteur Klinck reproduit le texte du manuscrit autographe conservé aux Archives de la Province de Québec.
