

THE BIBLIOGRAPHY OF CANADIAN BIBLIOGRAPHIES

The long-awaited BCB will be published by the University of Toronto Press this summer. It will be a volume of 240 pages, with a list price of \$10.00. (Members of the Society will be entitled to a special price of \$8.00). In order to give our members advance information about the contents of the BCB, we are reproducing here the Introduction which will appear in the published volume:

"Bibliographies listed here conform to the following definition: a bibliography is a list of books, brochures, newspapers, periodicals, maps, manuscripts, or their reproductions, with information for their identification (author, title, place, date, publisher). Furthermore, their subject is wholly or principally Canadian (person, event, place, etc.)

The following categories have been omitted:

- a) bibliographies or catalogues on cards, unless a list is expected to be made available for circulation;
- b) bibliographies included in a monograph or in a periodical article;
- c) catalogues and price lists of publishers, booksellers and secondhand book-dealers;
- d) analytical writings on bibliography or on source material;
- e) subject or name indexes;
- f) directories, trade lists, biographical dictionaries containing cursory bibliographies.

Items in category b) are so numerous that it is impossible to list them all. Some have been included for the convenience of the general reader, but this does not imply discrimination against bibliographies omitted. Research workers know the scholarly works in their fields and expect them to contain relevant bibliographies.

The decision to omit publishers' and booksellers' catalogues was taken with regret, for some of these lists contain useful bibliographical information. Many of them, however, are ephemeral, difficult to consult, and are intended only to promote sales.

Lists submitted by students usually do not have the same value as those prepared by experienced bibliographers; nevertheless, even such preliminary lists can be useful, and we have listed all those brought to our attention. The name of the school follows the collation.

The bibliographies are arranged according to their main subject. A bilingual index gives the necessary references. Biobibliographies make up a single group, regardless of the subject in which the writers may have specialized. Names of authors, as well as of bibliographers, appear in the alphabetical index with references to entry numbers. Between classes, numbers remain available for eventual addenda."

METROPOLITAN TORONTO BIBLIOGRAPHICAL CENTRE

Plans for the development of the Metropolitan Bibliographical Centre at the Toronto Reference Library are now under way, and it is hoped that the Centre, under the direction of Miss Dorothy Dingle, will open on or about April 1, 1960. The main function of the new Centre will be to bring together bibliographical information on all the book resources of the Toronto Public Library system, and thus to serve enquirers in the Metropolitan Toronto area.

CANADIAN BOOK PRICES CURRENT

Volume II of Robert M. Hamilton's <u>Canadian Book Prices Current</u> has now appeared. This new volume, published by McClelland and Stewart, lists all rare or out-of-print Canadian books or works of Canadian interest, sold or listed for sale at a price of \$2.50 or more during the years 1956 to 1958. There are more than 7,500 main entries, not including later editions or variant printings. Price \$22.50.
